

CSULA, CSULB, CAL POLY POMONA, CSUF -SPRING 2021 ADMISSIONS

Although Fall applicants are on their way to their new campuses, many CSU campuses will be admitting students for their Spring 2021 semester. 22 out of the 23 campuses are open for admission to all students. Some of which will include: CSULA, CSULB, and Cal Poly Pomona. CSUDH and CSUN, however, are open for Veterans and International students only. Please refer to the link below for specific admission requirements for each campus. application filing period is from August 1st -30th. For those interested in applying, they must meet the following criteria no later than Summer 2020: 60 transferrable units, golden 4, and major preparation courses completed. We encourage all students who are ready to transfer to apply. If you are unsure whether or not you meet this criteria, please make an appointment with a counselor to find out. And to those who will be applying, the Transfer Center is happy to provide application assistance.

WHERE DO UC YOURSELF?

UC TRANSFER ADMISSION GUARANTEE

Six UC campuses offer the Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) program for California community college students who meet specific requirements. By participating in TAG, you may receive early review of your academic records, early admission notification and specific guidance about major preparation and general education coursework. TAG applications are due Sept. 30, but you can only TAG to one of the six campuses. To keep your options open, apply to other UC campuses during the regular application period (Nov. 1-30). In order to apply, you will need to create a TAP account at:

APPLICATION TIPS

Applying to transfer is big step in a student's educational journey. We want to ensure that everyone is successful in transferring over to a 4-year institution, but we understand transfer is not a straight line. The Transfer Center has created tips In order to assist you in your application process.

- 1. Get a head start on personal statements and UC Personal Insight Questions.
- Visit the UC website and look over the questions and start thinking about what you are going to write about.
- 2. Meet with a counselor at LEAST once a semester to update your educational plan.
- 3. Keep your GPA up and go to virtual office hours.
- 4. Visit university websites and attend a virtual tour to get a sense of the campus. Look at department sites to find out what is expected once you transfer over.
