#### Program Description

The program is designed to award the Associate in Arts in Music for Transfer Degree for those students who plan to transfer to a California State University. Students who successfully earn the Associate in Arts in Music for Transfer Degree by completing a maximum of 60 transferable units are guaranteed transfer admission into a California State University campus to further their study of Music.

#### Career and Transfer Opportunities

Please note that due to the limited number of required music courses, this degree will lead to a Bachelor of Arts degree, not a Bachelor of Music. If students supplement the AA-T course requirements with further music courses in piano, music history, among others, graduates of our AA-T Music Degree are prepared to transfer to a four-year university/college into a variety of music-related Bachelor's Degree programs, including: performance, music education, music theory, music composition, musicology, and music therapy. Students who complete our AA Music Degree program and transfer to and complete a Bachelor's and/or Master's Degree in Music can expect a salary range starting at \$20,000 and potentially up to as high as \$145,000. Some job titles can include: performer (orchestra member, studio musician, etc.), teacher (K-12, college, private studio), church musician, music director, arts management, music therapist, composer/orchestrator/arranger (film, TV, video games, commercials).
