A paid internship program within the entertainment industry

The Mayor's Office is helping place work-ready young adults into paid internships within the Entertainment Industry which includes TV, Film, Music, Digital Media, Live Events, and Journalism. Students are eligible for a variety of positions within the industry including those at talent agencies and music labels, within marketing/PR, production and post-production, art, animation, administrative, event production and more.

The program will also train students in the soft skills they need to be competitive for these positions. Students enrolled in the program are eligible to receive transportation support services and attend educational site visits. Previous site visits included a lot tour and panel discussion at Warner Bros, an Original Content "pitch workshop" at Netflix, and studio tours and resume workshops at BuzzFeed.

- Between 18-24 years of age
- Right to work in the U.S.
- Resident of the City of Los Angeles

- Ability to work approx. 16-25 hours per week
- All majors are encouraged to apply
