## CSU Apply Supplemental Application Update

After submitting your CSU application, you may be required to submit a Supplemental Application. Some schools might have you update your application through CSU Apply and some might have you complete a separate supplemental application through their website. Please check the student portals for each school that you applied to and your emails and complete them by the deadline!

It is critical that the Supplemental Application is accurately completed in its entirety and submitted by the deadline date. Visit us in the Transfer Center if you need help or have questions.

## The Common Application is Now Open.

Many private and out-of-state schools will have their application available through the Common Application. The Common App is an undergraduate college admission application that applicants may use to apply to any of 731 colleges & universities in 48 states, Canada, China and many European countries.



## Graduation Petitions & AA-T/AS-T Verification forms

Are you ready to graduate? Did you complete all requirements for your Associate degree or Certificate of Achievement? Great! Your next step is to make an appointment with a counselor at the Transfer Center. You may submit graduation petitions for Spring 2018 starting on **Feb 19<sup>th</sup>**.

If you are completing an Associate's Degree to Transfer, make sure to let your counselor know and submit a "Verification of AA-T/AS-T" form. Be sure to **complete the verification by March 15<sup>th</sup>** so that it can be verified electronically.

### Tips & Reminders

- CSU & UC Applicants make sure to create student portals for each university that requests it. The university may have emailed you a CIN (Campus ID Number), which is what you will include in all future correspondences with that school. Additional materials/documentation may be requested from certain institutions. Please make sure to check the [To Do List](#) on your Student Portals to complete and turn in anything that's requested of you.
- **Spring semester begins February 5, 2018.** All students planning to transfer to a UC/CSU in Fall 2018 will need to have the following completed by the end of the Spring semester:
  - 60 transferable units
  - English 101
  - Critical Thinking course
  - College-level Math course
  - Communications 101 (for CSU only)
- Please do not send official transcripts until the university requests you to do so.
- **International students or veteran students:** Some CSU's are still accepting applications for Fall 2018! Visit D7 for more info.
- Bay Area University Trip Applicants will be notified if they have been selected for an interview by **February 15<sup>th</sup>**
