International Student Transfer Timeline

- February-May (sometimes June): Letters of Acceptance
 - Wait to hear from all universities before making a decision
 - May 1st** is usually the deadline for Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) for **CSU's** and **June 1st** for **UC's**
 - Can SIR multiple CSU's, but **ONLY 1 UC!**
- February-June: Submit Graduation Petition signed by Counselor to Admissions E1 105
- May/June: Submit Transfer Out Release Form to ISO, G1 101 with acceptance letter
- Continue to check email daily for any updates or documents needed including University Orientation Fee
- May: Attend International Transfer Celebration on **Friday, May 18th** (Registration Form due to ISO, G1 101 by Monday, May 7th 4pm with Acceptance Letter)
- May: Attend Transfer Center Reception on **Thursday, May 24th 6pm** (Sign up in the Transfer Center, D7 by Monday, May 18th with Acceptance Letter)
- June: Attend ELAC Graduation Ceremony on **June 5th 6pm** (Graduation Gown can be borrowed from the ISO G1 101 and Cap and Tassel can be Purchased in the Bookstore. Cap and Gown set is **\$59**. Graduation Fair price on Thursday, May 17th 10am-2pm for **\$38**.)
- June: Order official transcripts with CSU or IGETC Certification request form attached to Transcript Request form in Admissions, E1 105 by due date (usually **June 30th**)
- If traveling to home country during summer before transfer, get New I-20 with Travel Signature from new school and be sure to give home country address
- July/August: Attend University Orientation

Note: Requirements can change at any given time
