Degree Path and Requirements:

This program is appropriate for students considering law schools as well as certain careers in criminal justice. The Associate of Science in Administration of Justice transfer degree can also lead to careers in law enforcement, courts, and corrections. Students are required to complete a minimum of 60 required semester units of CSU transferable coursework with a minimum GPA of 2.0, including a minimum of 18-19 semester units in the major with a minimum grade of "C" (or "P") for each course in the major.
