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# **Degree Path and Requirements:**

The Associate in Arts in Art History for Transfer Degree offers academic training in visual literacy of Europe, Asia, Africa, and the Americas. Emphasis on visual, written, and oral communication and the language and methodology of art history prepares students for university transfer and to compete in upper-division coursework in a range of disciplines including the history of art and visual communication. Students must complete 60 required semester units of CSU transferable course work with a minimum grade point average of 2.0 including a minimum grade of "C" (or "P") for each course in the major. Certified completion of the California State University General Education-Breadth (CSU GE Breadth) or Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) Pattern is also required.

This map is a suggested term-by-term sequence of courses to complete the program in a recommended time frame. This is an efficient and recommended plan, but actual plans may vary by individual student need. This map cannot replace a meeting with <u>counselors</u>.

## **Department Advising Notes:**

Listed are recommended classes in all areas satisfying University of California Transfer Requirement; courses listed support a program of study in the history of art and visual culture. This is a recommended guide and other courses are available for you to take in certain areas--refer to the Catalogue of Classes and/or schedule an appointment with a counselor for more information. Transfer Requirements for California State University vary slightly.

# **Program Description**

Students completing the AA degree in Art History will be able to analyze, interpret, and present ideas, utilizing the specific language of art, in the comparative evaluation of the techniques and methods, functions, and aesthetics of world visual cultures effectively; and in doing so demonstrate awareness and appreciation of the cultures, religion, and traditions of peoples of the world.

### **Career and Transfer Opportunities**

The Associate in Arts Degree in Art History prepares students to transfer to a four year institution to pursue a BA degree, and/or for entry level gallery and museum work. This transfer degree guarantees admission to the California State University system.
