Degree Path and Requirements:

This program is designed for students who wish to become a site supervisor in an Early Childhood Education center or home based program. This certificate is designed to be stackable with Teacher Certificates 1 and 2, and with specialization certificates such as Infant/Toddler and/or Children with Special Needs.

Students can choose to take accelerated 8-week versions of most classes, and can complete 3 certificates in just 3 semesters– Associate Teacher 1, Infant and Toddler Emphasis, Children with Special Needs on their way to completing this program.

Experience requirements are completion of 350 days + hours per day within four years, including at least one year of supervising adults in ECE settings. Further courses may be required to qualify for Child Development Permit Matrix level of Site Supervisor.
