Degree Path and Requirements:

Students can apply for certificates as soon as the necessary courses and hours are completed. This certificate requires 50 days of at least 3 hours per day of teaching experience in an ECE setting.

The CFES department suggests continuing on to Teacher 2 and Teacher 3 certificates, or specialized Infant/Toddler or Children with Special Needs. These certificates can be stacked while working to attain an AA or AS-T degree.

Students can choose to take accelerated 8-week versions of most classes, and can complete 3 certificates in just 3 semesters—Associate Teacher 1, Infant and Toddler Emphasis, Children with Special Needs

Semester 1: CH DEV 001, 002, 044, 045

Intersession: CH DEV 011

Semester 2: CH DEV 003 or 004, 030, 031, 062

Must complete 150 hours for Associate Teacher 1 Certificate.

Program Description

This first certificate of the Child Development program is designed for students who wish to become a teacher in an Early Childhood Program. The certificate meets Title 22 and 5 guidelines. Requires 50 days (of at least 3 hours per day) teaching experience supervised by a full-time permitted and/or credentialed teacher in an approved and licensed ECE setting. Experience can be paid and/or volunteer and must be met within the last two years from the date of certificate application submission.

Career and Transfer Opportunities

Visit the <u>Transfer Center</u> for transfer information, which varies based on transfer college. Make an appointment with a <u>counselor</u>. Students can visit <u>Career and Job Services</u> for career counseling and further exploration. For additional resources, students pursuing a certificate can visit the <u>American Job Center of California</u> on ELAC main campus.

Meet with a counselor and the financial aid office to ensure continued financial aid. Check with financial aid for eligibility.
