This degree program is an excellent choice for someone wanting to pursue a career in care, administration, or program planning in the field of Child Development. Early education programming is shaped by individuals with this type of background. We suggest working toward at least 1 Child Development certificate while in the process of this degree (See all options below).

Upon completion of these classes and required volunteer/work hours, you may be eligible to apply for several certificates.

Students can choose to take accelerated 8-week versions of most classes, and can complete 3 certificates in just 3 semesters—Associate Teacher 1, Infant and Toddler Emphasis, Children with Special Needs on their way to completing this program. (Note: 150 hours must be completed for Associate Teacher 1 Certificate)
