Degree Path and Requirements:

This degree program is an excellent choice for someone wanting to pursue a career in care, administration, or program planning in the field of Child Development. Early education programming is shaped by individuals with this type of background.

Department Advising Notes:

We suggest working toward at least 1 Child Development certificate while in the process of this degree. (See all options below). Upon completion of these classes and required volunteer/work hours, you may be eligible to apply for several certificates. Students can choose to take accelerated 8-week versions of most classes, and can complete 3 certificates in just 3 semesters: Associate Teacher 1, Infant and Toddler Emphasis, and Children with Special Needs on their way to completing this program. Semester 1: CH DEV 001, 002, 044, 045, Intersession: CH DEV 011, Semester 2: CH DEV 003 or 004, 030, 031, 062 (Must complete 150 hours for Associate Teacher 1 Certificate)

Program Description

The Associates in Arts in Early Childhood Education for Transfer focuses on the theory and practice of early childhood care and education for children from birth to age eight. Students must complete 60 required semester units of CSU transferable course work. The course of study includes the basic principles of educational and developmental psychology; the art of observing, teaching and guiding young children; planning and administration of developmentally appropriate inclusive educational activities; school safety and health issues; and the social and emotional foundations of early care and education. Students completing this program have the potential of obtaining occupations in educational settings such as infant/toddler caregivers; preschool teachers; family home childcare providers; master teachers, site supervisors, program directors, child life specialists, and social services workers. Students prepare to transfer to four-year schools to pursue advanced degrees in child development with the eventual goal of becoming Early Childhood Education (ECE) program directors, center principals, elementary school teachers, resource specialists, ECE resource specialists, consultants, or finding employment in related human service fields.

Career and Transfer Opportunities

Visit the transfer center for transfer and guaranteed transfer information, which varies based on transfer college. Make an appointment with a counselor for transfer information. For additional resources, students pursuing a certificate can visit the American Job Center of California on ELAC's main campus. Some career options include: Infant & Toddler Care, Special Needs Specialist, Applied Behavior Analysis, Policy Development, Child Advocacy, Grant Writing, Counseling, Foster Care and Adoption, Mental Health Services, Family Childcare Provider, Educational Television, and Family Support Services.
