Aside from offering 2 years of community college free, ELAC College Promise provides scholars with a summer transition activity, registration support, First-Year Center mentors, dedicated counselors and support staff, cohort courses, incentives, and opportunities for international travel through the Los Angeles City Mayors' Young Ambassadors Program.



Eligibility Requirements

-  **Must be a first time college student.**
-  **Submit a FAFSA or California Dream Act Application during your senior year of high school.** - Complete the FAFSA at www.fafsa.ed.gov (Federal School Code: 001222) **or the** CA Dream Act at www.dream.csac.ca.gov (Dream Act School Code: 02226000).
-  **Must be a California resident, permanent resident, and/or qualify for the California Dream Act.**
-  **Must enroll full-time, 12-units.*** (Accommodations for minimum enrollment may be provided, as appropriate to scholars in the Diversabilities Support Program & Services.)

Enrollment for the ELAC Promise

-  **Apply to East Los Angeles College.** - Submit at application online at <http://laccd.edu/apply>. It takes approximately 3 business days to generate student ID number.
-  **Complete the LA College Promise application.** - Go to www.lacollegepromise.org. This will require a student ID number.
-  **Complete New Student Orientation.** - Available online through the PeopleSoft SIS Portal or by visiting: <https://launch.comevo.com/elac/982>.
-  **Complete your Educational Plan with an ELAC counselor.**
-  **Scholars interested in the ELAC Promise must apply for FAFSA or the DREAM ACT, regardless of family income.**



Frequently Asked Questions

Is the Summer Transition Activity Mandatory?

Yes. In order to qualify for ELAC Promise benefits, scholars must complete the Summer Transition Activity.

Do I have to apply for Financial Aid (FAFSA or DREAM ACT) to be a part of ELAC College Promise?

Yes. All scholars regardless of whether or not they think they qualify, must apply.

First Year Requirements

- Ensure all enrollment steps on previous page are completed.

Summer

- Summer Transition Activity.
- Check your registration status on ELAC SIS to find your registration date and enroll in Fall courses.

Fall

- Enroll in a minimum of 12 units. (See Eligibility Requirements for exceptions.)
- Student Success Activities. - Attend ELAC workshops, meet with an FYC Mentor and complete 5 hours of tutoring in your first few weeks.
- Student Educational Plan (SEP). - Meet with a FYC counselor and develop a comprehensive educational plan. An appointment can be made at the First-Year Center to discuss educational goals.
- Re-Apply to FAFSA or California Dream Act. - The priority deadline for the following year is March 2nd to qualify for most funding. The application opens in October.
- Check your registration status on ELAC SIS to find your registration date and enroll in Spring courses.
- Maintain 2.0 GPA.

Spring

- Enroll in a minimum of 12 units. (See Eligibility Requirements for exceptions.)
- Student Success Activities.
- Student Educational Plan (SEP). - Meet with an FYC counselor for any updates or changes to the comprehensive educational plan.
- Check your registration status on ELAC SIS to find your registration date and enroll in Spring courses.
- Maintain 2.0 GPA.
- Transfer - If planning to transfer, meet with a counselor in the Transfer Center. Take advantage of resources, such as college tours, Summer Scholars Transfer Institute, application assistance, etc.

Second Year Requirements

- To be eligible for the 2nd year, ELAC College Promise scholars must have completed at least 24 units at ELAC with a minimum 2.0 GPA.

Fall

- Enroll in a minimum of 12 units. (See Eligibility Requirements for exceptions.)
- Student Success Activities.
- Graduation Check - Meet with a counselor to ensure you are on the path to graduate and/or transfer.
- Transfer Applications - If you are ready to transfer, complete CSU/UC/Private school applications. Get support with the process from the Transfer Center in order to meet deadlines.
- Re-apply to FAFSA or California Dream Act - Apply for FAFSA or California Dream Act, for your 3rd year, the priority deadline is March 2nd to qualify for the most funding. The application opens in October. If transferring, make sure to add all school codes to the college you are applying to.
- Check your registration status on ELAC SIS to find your registration date and enroll in Spring courses.
- Maintain 2.0 GPA.

Spring

- Enroll in a minimum of 12 units. (See Eligibility Requirements for exceptions.)
- Graduation Petition - Ready to graduate? If so, you should submit your graduation petition by the deadline to ensure inclusion in the commencement program.
- Career Center - Meet with a counselor from the Career Center to discuss internship opportunities.
- Maintain 2.0 GPA.
