Requirements for AA-T or AS-T degrees: The completion of 60 semester units that are eligible for transfer to the California State University, including both of the following:

- The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) or the California State University Breadth Requirements.
- · A minimum of 18 semester units in a major area of emphasis, as determined by the district.

- The obtainment of a minimum grade point average of 2.0.
- The completion of all courses required for the major with a 'C' or better.

This transfer degree guarantees admission to the California State University system.
