#### **Pathway to Law School Transfer Program**

The Pathway to Law School Transfer Program at ELAC is a member of the California State Bar’s “Community College Pathway to Law School” Initiative. Participants in the program who have completed all requirements for transfer to a four-year institution and the seven courses required by the California State Bar will receive preferential consideration upon applying to any of the six law schools in California that are partners in the State Bar’s Initiative.

For those students interested in a legal career, the advantages of the Pathway are that the program will: demystify law school with visits to law classes, moot court competitions, bar events and scholarly presentations. In addition, students have access to a designated counselor and are provided with opportunities to do internships and service learning. Students also have opportunities to network with law students, attorneys, judges, and other students, attorneys, and one another.

The following courses are required for the Pathway to Law School Transfer Program:

Political Science 1, Sociology 14, History 11 or History 12, Communication Studies 103, English 101, English 103, and Math 227.
