Complete additional degree applicable units, if needed, to meet the 60-unit requirement for the degree.

No more than two courses from any one subject area may be applied to this 18-unit Area of Emphasis. Note: Only one 5-unit Foreign Language course permitted.

Program Description

Students also learn to value aesthetic understanding and incorporate these concepts when constructing value judgements.
