In addition to physical fitness, dance and sports activities, the program includes the study of methods of teaching and coaching; rules, procedures and officiating of sports; history and principles of physical education and its relation to education in general.

Associate's degree program in PE has several career options in physical education however, additional certifications may be required in some areas. Possible jobs include:

Bachelor's degree or higher in PE are generally required for sports instructors and high school coaches. These positions may require additional teacher certification, depending on state regulations. Other career options:
