Noncredit Program: Basic Math Success, Certificate of Completion. This map is a suggested term-by-term sequence of courses to complete the program in a recommended time frame. Program Description

The Basic Math Success Certificate of Completion prepares students with the basic math skills to succeed in credit Math and other STEM subjects. The program can also complement a CTE program that requires solid computational skills.

Career and Transfer Opportunities

Academic Preparation courses are designed for students who wish to improve reading, writing, math, and study skills before enrolling in college-level credit courses. These courses also prepare students to take the GED/HiSET high school equivalency exams.
