Degree Path and Requirements:

To earn an AA-T in History, students must: a) complete 60 CSU transferable semester units (18 semester units in the approved History courses; Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) or the California State University General Education-Breadth Requirements (CSU GE); b) achieve a grade point average of 2.0; and c) earn a "C" (or "P") for each course in the major.

All of the above listed History Program courses are offered during the fall and spring semesters, and most of them are also offered during the intersessions.

Program Description

The Associate in Arts in History for Transfer creates a transfer pathway for students who plan to complete a Bachelor of Arts in History at a CSU, and is designed to provide students with an introduction to and overview of history, which is the study of change over time. Historians analyze cause and effect, construct narratives from primary sources, and explain the actions of people in the past. Students in history courses learn how to interpret, debate, and draw conclusions. History majors acquire a broad perspective on the human experience and appreciate how the past has shaped the present.

Career and Transfer Opportunities

Students who successfully earn the Associate in Arts in History for Transfer by completing a maximum of 60 transferable units are guaranteed transfer admission into a California State University campus to further the study of History and pursue completion of a Bachelor of Arts in History.
