Degree Path and Requirements:

This program is for students who wish to acquire an Associate in Arts degree with an emphasis on multimedia and video-related skills. This map is a suggested term-by-term sequence of courses to complete the program in a recommended time frame. Ultimately, the Art Department's program seeks to give the student every opportunity to develop his/her potential for aesthetic awareness, aesthetic expression, and critical analysis.

Program Description

The student completing the Multimedia AA degree will enhance their visual literacy through the acquisition of observational, technical and analytical skills.

Career and Transfer Opportunities

Students graduating with an AA degree in Multimedia would primarily get production work. This may be at a design studio or other business. It would usually involve doing the computer layout work following the instructions of an art director or lead designer. The main skills employers will be looking for are proficiency with Adobe software and animation software.
