Degree Path and Requirements:

Students who successfully earn the Associate in Arts in Studio Arts for Transfer by completing a maximum of 60 transferable units are guaranteed transfer admission into a California State University campus to further their study of Art. This map is a suggested term-by-term sequence of courses to complete the program in a recommended time frame. This is an efficient and recommended plan, but actual plans may vary by individual student need. This map cannot replace a meeting with counselors. Students can apply for certificates as soon as the necessary courses are completed. Meet with a counselor and the financial aid office to ensure continued financial aid. 3 courses/9 units are required from the Major Electives List B. Only 1 course/3 units are required from Major Electives List A.

Program Description

The student completing the Studio Arts AA-T will enhance their visual literacy through the acquisition of observational, technical and analytical skills.

Career and Transfer Opportunities

With a 4 year Degree Studio Arts majors can either continue their education in graduate school which would enable them to teach in the primary, secondary, or college level, or they can pursue jobs outside of academia such as, but not limited to, illustration- technical, fashion, medical biological advertising, etc. Students could secure jobs in design - product, transportation, jewelry, furniture, ceramic, textile, etc. Students could enter arts management - corporate art, art studio manager, artists' representative/agent, art consultant, film video, gallery public art administrator, etc. Students can also go into Art restoration, conservation, foundry work, painting services, etc.
