This Certificate of Achievement is designed for working in the Commercial Music Industry, as a Music Notation expert.

The certificate is designed and managed by commercial music professionals and provides students with skill sets not typically required in traditional music curricula. Students master the music notation software, Sibelius and become Avid certified. Students develop music notation techniques, explore notation styles, notations for various ensembles, study music theory, ear-training, instrumental transpositions, and develop sight-reading skills, and ensemble skills. Students enjoy the hand-on approach offered by commercial and traditional music faculty, with labs being a primary source of direct learning and collateral experience.
