Transfer Requirements

English 101, English 101Z, and E.S.L. 110 all satisfy English composition requirements for transfer to the **UC** (University of California and **CSU** (California State Universities).

24% higher pass rate

Students in English 101Z (previously English 101/72) on average pass with a 24% higher success rate than those who only take English 101.

How does English 101Z or ESL 110 help you? Courses are 3 hours longer per week for:

- more time to work on • more in-class discussion about difficult assignments.
- more time with your Professor • more time **learning** with **tutors during class!**
- more guidance on • more time in a computer writing and reading.lab!

Taking E.S.L. 110 is an excellent option because you will learn more grammar and practice with your professor and a specialized tutor who will guide you.
