A. PREREQUISITES FOR R.N. PROGRAM:

- Minimum of "C" is required in all prerequisite courses.
- A science GPA of 2.5 overall will be required in Anatomy, Physiology, & Microbiology courses. (Only one repeat for improved grade is allowed, and a 'W' does not count as a repeat).
- An overall cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher in all college coursework will be required.
- Latest version of TEAS score of 62% or higher in each of the four subcategories.
