The International Student Office (ISO) has dedicated counselors, bilingual staff, and international student peers. ISO offers several cultural events to showcase our international students, including Lunar New Year, Water Festival & Global coffee event, and sponsors multiple international student clubs, that highlight the diverse culture of our students. Our team also helps coordinate university tours, campus work opportunities and more.



Start at ELAC. Transfer Anywhere!

ELAC has transfer agreements with University of California (UC) schools, Cal States (CSU) and most private schools in California. Students complete the first 2-years of General Education and lower division major courses and transfer to a 4-year university for the last two years of upper-division courses, to obtain a bachelor's degree.

We also offer the UC Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) which give students transfer assistance and priority admission to select UC universities. With the TAG agreement, international students select one UC school and have guaranteed transfer admission if they meet TAG requirements. Students can apply for regular transfer admission to all UC, CSU, and private universities.



Here's all you need to know about getting started at ELAC.

International admission is offered for the Fall and Spring semesters. Application deadlines and start dates are listed at elac.edu.

- International CCCApply: students must complete the two-part international application process on CCCApply at bit.ly/3TjV2hH.
- English Competency: International students (F-1) are required to have a minimum TOEFL score of 450 (133 Computer-based TOEFL or Internet Based Test 45), an IELTS minimum score of 5 or a Duolingo score of 75. ELAC offers internet based English competency interview via Zoom.
- Academic Records: three years of high school or college translated in English.
- Bank Document: with equivalence of \$24,000 USD – one year estimate tuition and living costs.
- Financial Affidavit: signed by sponsor.
- International Application fee: \$50 USD.

Once all required documents are submitted by email (elac_iso@elac.edu), admission evaluation will be determined and accepted students will be emailed an acceptance letter and US Federal document I-20 in approximately a week.
